Fruity, lively and clean with surprising depth of flavour. Hints of greengage and lemon.		
2 Henriot Brut Souverain Champagne CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE	£12.00	£55.00
Brut Souverain is the flagship cuvee of Champagne Henriot, one of the oldest family owned houses. Elegant in style, with notes of honeysuckle and brioche. Lengthy finish.		
3 Henriot Rosé Champagne CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE		£65.00
Intense, complex and pleasantly fruity. The nose reveals aromas of red berry fruit and freshly squeezed pink citrus fruit. The palate offers lots of freshness and excellent balance in a harmonious aromatic register.		
4 Henriot Blanc de Blanc Champagne CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE		£75.00
Expressive with floral, fruity and pastry aromas, followed by spicy notes. The palate is full and powerful, with lightly toasted brioche, quince jelly and acacia honey.

5 Chardonnay “Sons de Prades” Milmanda Estate, Familia Torres CONCA DE BARBERA, SPAIN		£60.00
Straw-coloured wine with golden highlights. Fresh floral and pineapple aromas. Luscious, with delicate extract and a clean dry finish. Lovely with oil-rich fish.		
6 Chablis, 1er “Vaillons”, Domaine William Fèvre 2019 BURGUNDY, FRANCE		£85.00
The pedigree of Vaillons shines through in the classic mineral character of this wine. Domaine William Fèvre are one of the best producers in the region of Chablis and this wine is a true classic.		
7 Barbaresco Martinenga, Marchesi di Grésy PIEMONTE, ITALY		£125.00
Fine, gently floral nose with wild cherry and redcurrant fruit. Spicy and lifted with notes of dried herbs. More sour cherry fruit on the palate, which combines richness and structure with complex layers of balsamic, toasty notes, and dried fruits.		
8 Château Langoa Barton Grand Cru Classé, St Julien 2015 BORDEAUX, FRANCE		£130.00
Deep rich ruby in colour, this has a soft expression on the nose, layering redcurrant jelly and smoked oak. It has an enjoyably frank expression, and is a little softer than some from St-Julien in this vintage.		
9 Saint Joseph “Vignes de L’Hospice, Guigal 2015 RHONE, FRANCE		£140.00
Smart, sophisticated and joyfully good Syrah from this top producer in the northern Rhone. Think blackberry and wild raspberry, cracked black pepper, graphite and cedar.

Ripe fruit and floral aromas. The palate has plenty of melon and peachy stone fruit flavours, with a good crisp acidity and full and silky mouthfeel.

Aromas of lush, bright black cherry, blackberry and cassis draw you in. Round, rich, seamless tannins provide a robust backbone and supple mid-palate. Notes of cedar, vanilla and a hint of mocha linger on the finish.

This compelling organic red wine is aromatic and fruity with supple tannins, flowing into ripe notes of garrigue herbs and cherries.				
47 Cabernet/Syrah/Cinsault, Domaine de Tourelles BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON  				£36.00
The nose has an exotic mix of ripe fig, bright red cherry and plum fruit with star anise spice, it’s lifted and pronounced. The palate has beautifully ripe red fruit characters alongside fig and date notes.

Aromatic, and intense with great complexity. The palate has smoky, red fruits with tones of vanilla and spice. The texture is lush with soft tannins with long flavours of red fruits and vanilla.

This wine is outstanding. Rich black raspberry and black currant fruit intermixed with some graphite and floral notes are followed by a fleshy, full-bodied palate with impressive concentration, texture and length.	
50 Chateau Batailley Grand Cru, Pauillac BORDEAUX, FRANCE	£195.00
An attractive, expressive cabernet nose, with cassis notes in evidence on the palate. Very classic left bank claret from one of the oldest Chateaus. with just a touch of dry tannin on the finish.	
51 Cune Rioja Reserva RIOJA, SPAIN 	£75.00
A traditional style Rioja from this well-respected Spanish bodega. Soft and supple on the palate with good integration of wood and attractive fruit character.
